Missouri Family Health Council (MFHC) is a nonprofit organization that administers federal Title X funds for the state of Missouri. Title X provides family planning and related preventive health care services, primarily for people with low incomes. In 2008, the MFHC Title X network provided health care services to **74,595 people**.

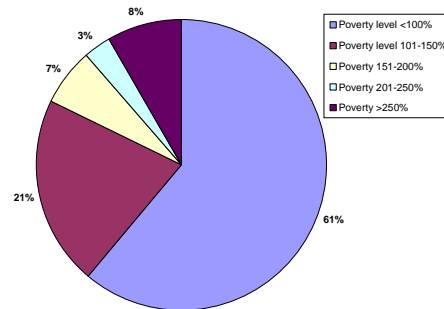
